Live-in care is when a professional carer comes to live with you in your own home and provides care, nursing support and companionship around the clock. Live-in care is a realistic alternative to moving into a nursing home or residential facility and could be a better option for many people.

With live-in care, you get consistent, one-to-one attention and support, tailored to your needs. You stay in the familiarity and comfort of your own home, which can significantly reduce stress and promote a sense of independence.

Live-in care means you can maintain your daily routine and mealtimes, and you can enjoy the same hobbies and social activities as before. You have safety, privacy and dignity and your family has peace of mind that you are receiving specialist, attentive care in your own home.

DIFFERENT TYPES OF LIVE-IN CARE

RESPITE CARE

Respite care is a short-term period of flexible care which can be arranged for periods to cover holidays, hospital convalescence or a period where a primary carer requires a break.

COMPANIONSHIP & SUPPORT

Companionship and support are very much a light touch of live-in care. It provides help with daily household chores, meal preparation, and support to maintain your place in the community and continue with hobbies and holidays. This level of care helps maintain a lifestyle and provides social stimulation, which helps with continued health and well-being.

PERSONAL CARE

Personal care is required when you or your loved one struggles with day-to-day tasks like maintaining personal hygiene, dressing, toileting or taking prescribed medication at regular times. Help with some of these intimate tasks can be very difficult for family members or loved ones to assist with and can be very stressful for both the person requiring the care and the loved one providing the care. Our highly trained professional carers deliver personal care with sensitivity, dignity, and respect working around your daily routines and lifestyle. Your carer can also include help with catheters and stoma bags.

COMPLEX CARE

This type of care is for anyone living with a long-term, progressive illness, degenerative disorder, or injury. Complex care is nurse-led care often supported by a team of specially trained carers. Each care package ensures you have the right level of care to guarantee you can live your life safely and well in the comfort of your own home.

LIVE-IN CARE FOR COUPLES

All of our tailored care packages can be provided for couples. Each individual will have their care needs assessed and personalised for them, and there can be a combined package that considers the joint needs of the couple.

COST OF LIVE-IN CARE



It is challenging to directly compare the cost of live-in care and a residential care home. Although ultimately, they both provide peace of mind for you, your family or your loved ones, they achieve this in a very different way.

However, the one-to-one care, benefit of remaining independent, active in the community, and avoiding the stress of separation while staying in the comfort of your own home means that live-in care's value far outweighs that of residential care.

The fully managed live-in care service that Alcedo Care provides for a single person is roughly around the same cost as a care home.

Live-in care for couples can be very cost-effective when compared to residential care. In most cases, care home fees for two will be double the price of a single placement, meaning that live-in care for couples can be significantly cheaper than residential care.

We think that live-in care is the best option for those that value their independence and want to spend most of the cost of care on one-to-one dedicated professional support.

All of our carers are employed directly by us, so our team take care of all salary and contract matters for you. This means that you can focus more on the relationship and support you receive from your carer, without any additional paperwork or conversations around money or payments.

Although most of our customers pay for their care themselves, there may be funding options or benefits available to you. These options include Attendance Allowance, Personal Independence Payments (PIP) and Social Services funding, and you can confirm your eligibility by speaking to your social worker or local council. You may also be eligible for Continuing Healthcare (CHC) funding, which is granted to people either with ongoing complex care needs who require intensive support at home on a permanent basis or those needing palliative care.

HOW TO GET STARTED

Anyone involved in your care (either yourself, a family member, or a member of your MDT such as your case manager, discharge team, social worker, etc.) can contact our professional team to discuss your requirements and any questions you have regarding the care service we offer.

If you want to proceed further, we will schedule a no-obligation visit in a convenient place for you with a member of our Complex Care team. This might be at home, or in an alternative setting such as hospital or residential accomodation.

This will be an opportunity for us to complete a detailed care assessment and evaluate your needs. Together with relevant health and social care professionals we will build a bespoke care plan specific to your individual requirements.

Once your assessment has been completed and level of care has been agreed, we then send you profiles of recommended carers. You will have the opportunity to meet with your proposed carer to ask questions and get to know them a little better. When you are happy to proceed, we complete the final details and arrange a start date.



What is a Live-in Carer?

A Live-in Carer is a trained care professional who stays and lives with you at your own home for a specific period of time. Live-in Carers help and support you around the clock with everything you need and ensure your needs are fully satisfied.

Why is it important to have regulated and managed care?

Having regulated care by CQC (England) and CIW (Wales) means that you can have peace of mind that you are receiving a fully regulated service by an independent body. Moreover, the service is regulated by our branch managers to ensure that you receive the best quality of service.

Do carers need their own room?

Yes, they do. It is essential that a carer has a place of their own where they can sleep and relax when they are not working. The minimum requirement is to provide the carer with a single bed and room that has a door to give them some privacy. Other than that the Live-In Carer can share all other facilities with you.

What do I need to provide for a live-in carer?

As a requirement the Live-In Carer must have a private room with a minimum of a single bed and wardrobe/chest of drawers where they can store their belongings while living with you. Another requirement is to provide them with Wi-Fi. When it comes to groceries, you can either buy your carer food or provide them with a food allowance every week.

How long will a carer stay with me?

Depending on your tailored personal plan, your Live-In Carer will stay in your property between 2 to 4 weeks (or duration that suits you). If your plan is more than 2-4 weeks then they need to take a break and a replacement carer will stay with you until your regular carer comes back. The two will then work on a rotation.

When do carers take time off and have a break? Every carer is entitled to 14 hours of breaks over the course of a working week, this can be divided in a way that suits you best. Typically it is split into two hours each day, or a few afternoons a week.
